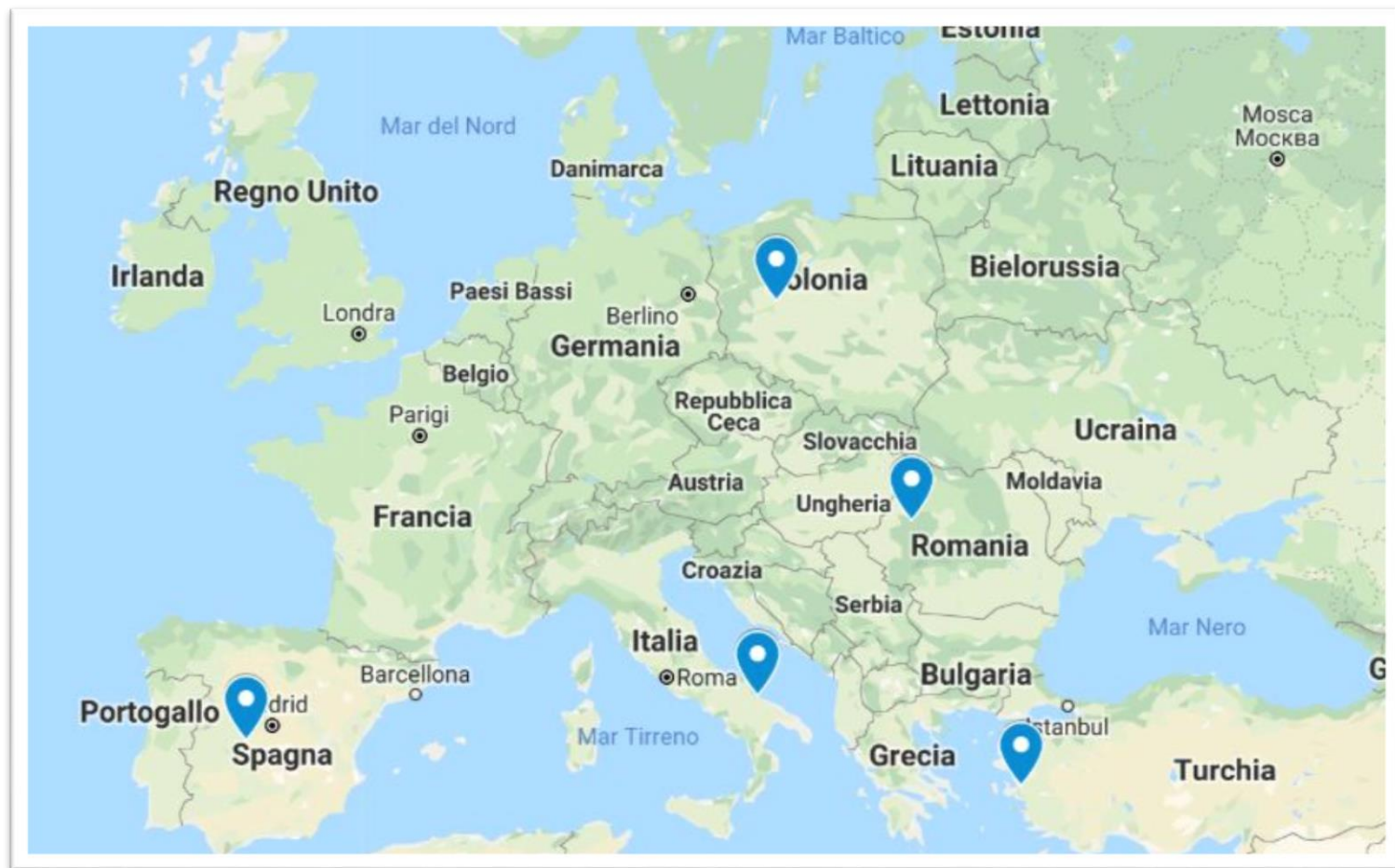
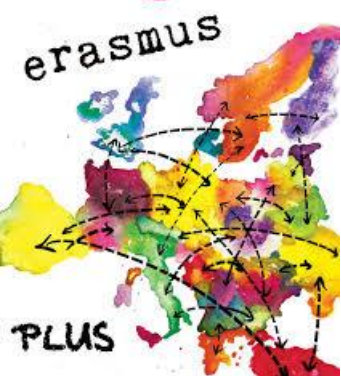

TIMETABLE

The timetable for each activity will be organized to cover different topics:

THE SELECTION CRITERIA



For the mobility (lasting **5 days**) the most deserving students will be chosen (**5 students for each partner country**). The selection criteria, explicitly stated in the project and which will be post on the website of each partner school, will allow a merit ranking to be formulated and will be based on:

- **Age:** exclusively pupils of lower secondary school;
- **English language skills**, based on the school marks reported in previous school years (mark 9 or similar according to the partner school's assessment system);
- **Good school mark average** in all other school subjects (mark 9 or similar according to the partner school's assessment system);
- **Assessment of behavior:** no students with behavioral penalties will be admitted
- **Disadvantaged students** will be considered provided that the above selection criteria are fulfilled (social, cultural, economic disadvantage)
- **Parents' willingness** to let their pupils take part to the physical mobility
- **Parents' willingness** to host pupils from partners

STUDENT'S PORTFOLIO



Each student will have his/her own portfolio with:

- a covering letter explaining his/her willingness/reasons to take part to the project;
- participation to previous school projects;
- declaration of commitment to the tasks related to the projects.

The students participating to the projects will attend extra English lessons and lessons regarding the culture, traditions, habits of the host country

There will be meetings with the parents of students participating to the mobility in order to provide references and contacts of host families and get their written consent or to get any info about diet restrictions.

School will take care of insurance about health, travel and any visa.
